## **Nxt Gen Futsal League Rules**

### **General Rules**

- 1. **Competition Format**: The competition will follow a league format.
- 2. **Team Composition**: Each team must consist of 5 players (4 outfield players and 1 goalkeeper) with a maximum of 7 substitutes.
- 3. **Game Duration**: Matches will be 25 minutes long with 5 minutes break in between matches.
- 4. **Timing**: There will be no stoppage time unless otherwise decided by the referees or tournament organisers.
- 5. **Substitutions**: Unlimited rolling substitutions are allowed. Substitutions must be made at the designated substitution zone.
- 6. **Uniforms**: Teams must wear matching jerseys. Goalkeepers must wear a colour that distinguishes them from outfield players and referees.

### **Match Rules**

- 1. **Kickoff**: The match begins with a kickoff from the center circle. Opposing players must be at least 3 meters away.
- 2. **Ball in Play**: The ball is always in play unless it completely crosses the goal line, touchline, or the referee stops play.
- 3. **Fouls and Misconduct**: Standard futsal fouls apply. Accumulated fouls will lead to a penalty kick if a team exceeds 5 fouls.

## 4. Goalkeeper Rules:

- Goalkeepers may handle the ball only within their penalty area.
- Goalkeepers must release the ball within 4 seconds.
- Goalkeepers cannot pick up the ball after it has been deliberately kicked to them by a teammate.

## 5. **Restarts**:

- Kick-ins replace throw-ins. The ball must be stationary and placed on or behind the touchline.
- Free kicks, goal kicks, and corner kicks must be taken within 4 seconds.

### League Rules

1. **Scoring**: A win awards 3 points, a draw 1 point, and a loss 0 points.

- 2. **Tiebreakers** (if applicable): In case of teams being tied in points, the following criteria will apply:
- Head-to-head result
- Goal difference
- Goals scored
- 3. **Code of Conduct**: Players, coaches, and spectators must adhere to fair play. Abusive language or unsportsmanlike behaviour will result in warnings, expulsions, or disqualification.

# **Equipment and Facilities**

- 1. Ball: A standard size 4 futsal ball will be used.
- 2. Footwear: Players must wear indoor shoes with non-marking soles. No cleats or studs are allowed.
- 3. Venue: Matches will be held on indoor futsal courts. Specific court rules (e.g., regarding walls or boundaries) will be clarified before matches.
